

Expressions of interest for Netball 2017

The 2017 Netball season is nearly upon us. The games are due to start early May.

All games are held at the Pukekohe Netball Courts.

We would like to get the teams organised early this year, as this will allow the children time to get a few practices in before the season starts.

Year 1-2 “fun ferns”

Held on a **Friday night from 4.30pm**

Children can come along and see what Netball is all about. Learn ball skills and the basic rules and enjoy mini netball games.

There is no minimum / maximum number of players needed for fun ferns. We do not need to supply a coach or hold training sessions. Children must be 5yrs old before 1 May 2015

Please note – registration for fun ferns is usually completed via the Pukekohe Netball Centre Website rather than through the school.

Year 3-4 “Future Ferns”

Games played on a **Friday Night** (two rounds –times to be confirmed but could be 5.30pm or 6.3pm)

Games are played 5 a side on 2/3 of the normal netball court. The goal posts are lower and the game is simplified. Coaches are allowed on the court to help their teams during the match.

This is a great introduction into the game of netball. All children are rotated around the different positions and get equal game time.

We need a minimum of 6 players and a maximum of 7.

We need to supply a coach and a manager. The coach would be required to turn up ½ hour before the Friday night games and learn a ball skill to teach their children before the match and assist with umpiring the games. Full support and instructions are given to the coaches. It would also be preferably (but not essential) if the coach could train the children during lunchtime or immediately after school one day per week.

Year 5 -6

Games are held on a **Saturday**. (times can vary from week to week)

These are standard netball games with full 7 aside teams.

We need a minimum of 7 players and a maximum of 10.

We would need to supply a coach / umpire for the games on Saturday. It would also be preferable if the coach was able to train the children during lunchtime or immediately after school one day per week. In the past we have used a mixture of parents and high school students to coach the team.
