8-30 am Parade We will try and put everyone in timeline order

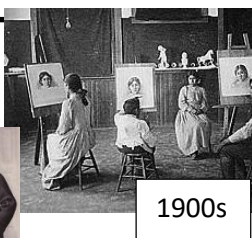
9-30 – 10 am Junior- Folk Dance Senior- Jump Jam

Excellent effort and result Kyla.



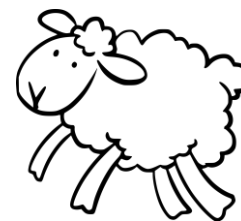
