MYCOPLASMA BOVIS RULES 2020

- A dedicated area for parking has been set up for calves. You will be directed on arrival. Calves are to be tied to their trailer until led to competition area.
- Photography for Year 6 students with calves will be at 9.30am in allocated area.
- Dairy Calf will be judged first in all 3 events.
- Calves must have their own food and water containers.
- Calves must have their own halter and lead.
- Calves must be kept 2 metres apart at all times.
- When entering or leaving allocated area you must sanitize with the sanitizer provided by the Calf Club Committee.
- Calves must be tied to allocated post at all times unless in the ring competing.
- Calves must stay in allocated area. Children must not walk around with them.
- Only the child competing and a parent/guardian are allowed in the allocated area.
- When ribbons are presented the child will come into the ring and stand by allocated marker with their calf.
- Once competitions are all completed the calves must stay within the allocated area.
